Under the direction of the Fire Chief, the Deputy Chief position will provide leadership and strategic direction to the department while advancing a positive and engaging workplace. The Deputy Chief will oversee training and operations, and other programs based on organizational needs. The Deputy Chief will bring strong interagency relations, community initiatives and a progressive leadership dynamic to our department.

Qualifications

- Minimum high school diploma, with ten (10) years related fire service experience, and two (2) years' experience as an officer. A suitable combination of education and experience may be considered.
- IFSAC/Pro-board certification in NFPA 1021 Level 2, NFPA 1041 Level 2, NFPA 1031 Level 1, and NFPA 1033.
- Other NFPA, post-secondary or related certifications are considered an asset.
- Ability to lead emergency services teams in a variety of situations, effectively managing support processes as well as developing and implementing improvements to facilitate excellence in integrated service delivery.
- Knowledgeable in leading technologies for emergency services, including Microsoft 365, Word and Excel.
- Fosters the development of a common vision by providing clear direction in alignment with strategic priorities, clarifying roles and responsibilities, creating a culture that is highly collaborative and inclusive.
- Ability to initiate, develop, and manage relationships with external agencies in both information and formal contract environments.
- Set an example for the organization's culture by operating with a high level of integrity and compassion.
- Exceptional organizational abilities, strong communication skills, and sound decision-making skills.
- Demonstrates professional standards and practice; exhibits noble character and personal values that align with the Terrace Fire Department's values and unified mission.
