

# CURBSIDE COLLECT 2025 GUIDELINES



"Our goal is to help the residents of the City of Terrace recycle, reduce overall contamination rates and decrease the amount of materials going to the landfill. Recycle in the present to save the future."

### **ALL MATERIALS: GARBAGE, RECYCLING & ORGANICS**

TO THE CURB **BEFORE** 8:00 am



All materials must be at the curbside by 8:00 am on the designated collection day.

Please note that carts/bags containing unacceptable materials will not be collected. The stickers on your cart are an attempt to raise awareness of contaminants in your cart.

### **Collection Day Cart Placement**

**Point It** 

Don't Bag your recyclables in your cart

- Do place your recyclables loose in the cart
- Additional recyclables to be placed in clear plastic bags beside cart

Carts must be at curbside, within 1 metre (3 feet) of the

travelled portion of the road. Position cart with arrows pointing to centre of road with at least 1 metre clearance around the cart as shown.

### **Garbage Collection**

- Curbside garbage is collected **alternating weeks** with recycling collection.
- Garbage is limited to one 240 litre cart per household every second week.
- If necessary for extra refuse a, "Garbage Tags" are available for \$2.00 each at any City office. The maximum weight of additional tagged refuse is 22kgs (50lbs) per bag.
- Large items can be taken to the Thornhill Transfer Station such as furniture, mattresses, electronics and liquids...
- No commercial waste, construction material in garbage or recycling.
- Cat litter, animal excrement, sawdust, cold ashes, broken glass, and wet refuse must be thoroughly drained, and wrapped in paper or plastic before being placed in the cart.

### **Recycling Collection**

- Curbside recycling is collected alternating weeks with garbage collection. Please visit www.terrace.ca/refuse or www.recyclebc.ca for a detailed list of acceptable materials at the curbside and at the depot.
- There is no limit to recycling placed at curbside, but collection is restricted to recycling materials from the residence.
- Recycling materials should be placed loosely / directly in the cart, not in bags. Additional materials shall be placed in transparent (clear) plastic bags beside the cart once your cart is full.
- Glass, Styrofoam, plastic bags, and overwrap are not accepted in curbside recycling. These items can be taken to the local Recycle BC Depot, "Do Your Part Recycling" located at 3467 Hwy 16 East.
- All cardboard must be flattened and cut to 30"x30" or less both in and out of the cart. Additional cardboard must be flattened, cut/folded, and tied in bundles no larger than 8" thick x 30" wide x 30" tall and placed beside recycling cart for pick up.
- If we find unaccepted materials in your recycling cart, your recycling may not get collected. Please remove any unaccepted materials so we can pick up your recycling cart next time.

- Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, coffee, etc.
- ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.
- ✓ Plastic pails less that 25L for laundry detergent, etc.

YARD WASTE DROP-OFF WILL RUN MONDAY'S STARTING THE SECOND MONDAY IN APRIL TO THE 3RD MONDAY IN NOVEMBER AT 5003 GRAHAM BETWEEN 8:30AM-4:00PM Additional Saturdays will also be available in the Spring and Fall for extra yard waste drop-off

Yard waste is composted at the City works yard and is used in City parks and boulevard

- Small branches less than 12 mm (1/2 inch) in diameter and less than 1 metre (3 feet) in
- . There is no bag limit on yard waste collection, but maximum weight per bag should not exceed 22kgs (50lbs).

NO cooked food, oil, meat, fish, bones, animal waste, and household refuse accepted in curbside yard waste drop off.




