AFFORDABLE RECREATION ACCESS PROGRAM

The City of Terrace's Parks, Recreation & Culture department offers the Affordable Recreation Access Program to individuals who receive funding or benefits through the following programs:



Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction

- Regular Income Assistance Benefits (must be renewed every six (6) months)
- Persons with Disabilities (PWD) (must be renewed annually)
- Persons with Persistent Multiple Barriers (PPMB) (must be renewed every six (6) months)

Ministry of Employment and Social Development Canada

Canada Pension Plan Disability (CPPD) (must be renewed every six (6) months)

How to Prove Eligibility

- Persons wishing to apply for the Affordable Recreation Access Program must submit a completed copy of the Affordable Recreation Access Program form and proof of funding or benefits.
- Persons receiving benefits from the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction (Regular Income Assistance Benefits, Persons with Disabilities (PWD), or Persons with Persistent Multiple Barriers (PPMB)) must provide a Release of Personal Information (Form HR0095). This form can be found at Service BC or through the My Self Serve portal at www.myselfserve.gov.bc.ca.
- Persons receiving benefits through the Canada Pension Plan Disability (CPPD), the Guaranteed Income Supplement for Seniors (GIS), or the Child Disability Benefit (CDB) must provide a copy of the standard benefit letter provided by the City of Terrace's Park's Recreation & Culture department, available at the front counter at the Sportsplex or the Terrace & District Aquatic Centre.

What Will I Receive?

Persons who qualify for the Affordable Recreation Access Program will be issued a discount card with an expiry date following the above guidelines. This card will allow qualifying persons to receive a 50% discount on drop-in fees, a 10-Visit Recreation Membership, a 1-Month Recreation Membership, or a 3-Month Recreation Membership. Memberships must be purchased within the expiry date on the discount card. Fitness class registration, facility rentals, swimming lessons, or other registerable activities are not included in this program. Persons receiving regular income assistance benefits will receive a discount card for themselves and up to 3 dependent children living in the household.

How Do I Apply?

- 1. Pick up the application and accompanying letter from the front desk at either the Sportsplex or the Terrace and District Aquatic Centre
- 2. Complete the application form and bring to the appropriate verifying department Service BC or Service Canada
- 3. Bring completed paperwork to either the Sportsplex or the Terrace & District Aquatic Centre

There is no limit to the number of times a person can apply for the Affordable Recreation Access Program.
